## NIJ Safety Notice #01-2010

SUBJECT: First Choice Armor & Equipment Body Armor Model TBL II S6XF

The National Institute of Justice (NIJ) hereby advises that First Choice Armor & Equipment Body Armor model number TBL II S6XF has been permanently removed from the NIJ Compliant Products List due to unresolved safety concerns. Any armors of this model should be replaced as soon as possible.

NIJ encourages law enforcement and corrections officers to continue to wear their body armor until it is replaced. Wearing untested armor is better than not wearing any armor.
