## NIJ Advisory Notice #29-2011

SUBJECT: Valley Operational Wear, Model PRV3L3A

The National Institute of Justice (NIJ) hereby advises that Valley Operational Wear, Model PRV3L3A has been suspended from the NIJ Compliant Products List. Suspension has occurred because of the noncompliance of production samples with our continued compliance monitoring program. Following the completion of an ongoing evaluation, the compliance status of this model will be updated on the ballistic body armor Compliant Product List (CPL).

Law enforcement and corrections officers currently wearing this model of armor are encouraged to continue wearing it or other NIJ Compliant Body Armor and to periodically check the ballistic body armor CPL for resolution or removal of this notice.
