



LISTED COMPANY PRODUCTION LABELS

In an effort to facilitate improved documentation for all listed companies associated with individual ballistic body armor models, the National Institute of Justice Compliance Testing Program (NIJ CTP) will require participants of the program to submit a representative label for all listed companies associated with each ballistic body armor model through the Testing Information Management System (TIMS). This requirement will become effective for all Initial Type Testing (ITT) submissions on or after January 1, 2021. All listed company labels submitted to the program must meet the labeling requirements identified in the [NIJ CTP Product Conformity Assessment System – Ballistic Body Armor Initial Type Testing \(ITT\) Scheme, version 1.1](#) in order to be approved for publication on the NIJ Compliant Product List (CPL).

Ballistic body armor models that are either currently in the NIJ CTP approval process or on the NIJ CPL will be required to submit representative labels for all listed companies associated with individual ballistic body armor models during their next scheduled Follow Up Inspection and Testing (FIT) in order to remain compliant with the NIJ CTP requirements.

If a participant of the program wants to add a listed company to an existing NIJ approved ballistic body armor model, a representative label must be provided at the time of the request to be considered for listing on the NIJ CPL.
